One or more additional pottery related films would be screened. Appropriate snacks (popcorn and candy) will be served during the movies. The dinner will take place at 5pm at the Borsari Gallery, which is also on Route 6A in Dennis.

During the week the gallery is a tearoom and exhibits the photography of Andrew Borsari and the etchings, oils and lithographs of David Grose. Our dinner, the evening of Sunday, February 21, will be a buffet and the planned menu will be sole with a seafood stuffing, chicken marango, rice pilaf, and a salad of mixed greens, followed by tea and coffee. Soup bowls may be hand built or wheel thrown and should easily hold one and a half cups of soup. Bowls may be dropped off as soon as possible at Kemp Pottery in Orleans, Heart Pottery in Brewster, the Creative Arts Center in Chatham, and Dean Pottery in Marston Mills.
